

## WHAT IS THE WONDERLIC ATB TEST AND WHY DO I HAVE TO TAKE IT?

The Wonderlic ATB test is one of the tests approved by the Federal Financial Aid Commission to qualify you for a PELL Grant. At BPACE, we are authorized to give this test. You are taking this test because:

- You are applying for financial aid to help pay for a Career Technical Education class at BPACE.
- You do not have your GED or your high school diploma from the United States.
- You have completed your education in another country and have not had your records translated and evaluated.

You must be referred by the Financial Aid office. Please see our Financial Aid specialist for more information.

## HOW DO I TAKE THE WONDERLIC ATB TEST AT BPACE?

At BPACE, we give the test once a month. The Financial Aid office will sign you up for the test.

You will need a picture ID.

The test takes about one hour to complete:

- 20 minutes for the Quantitative test
- 20 minutes for the Verbal test
- 20 minutes for administration instructions, etc.

Please be on time for the test. We will start promptly. If you are late, you will have to reschedule the test.

The minimum required passing scores accepted by the United States Department of Education are:

- Verbal 200
- Quantitative 210

Your scores are sent to the PELL Grant office. You may contact that office three working days after you take the test to get your results.

## CAN I STUDY FOR THE WONDERLIC ATB TEST?

You can study for the Wonderlic ATB test. The test covers basic skills in reading and math. You can get a study guide from the public library for the Wonderlic, GED, or CAHSEE. You can also get a short review at [www.testpreview.com](http://www.testpreview.com).

## OK. I TOOK THE TEST. DO I STILL NEED A GED OR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA?

**YES!** If you are taking a class that qualifies for a PELL Grant, prospective employers will probably be asking for a high school diploma or a GED when you apply for a job.

Come back to the Counseling office and talk to a counselor about how to get your high school diploma or GED from BPACE.
